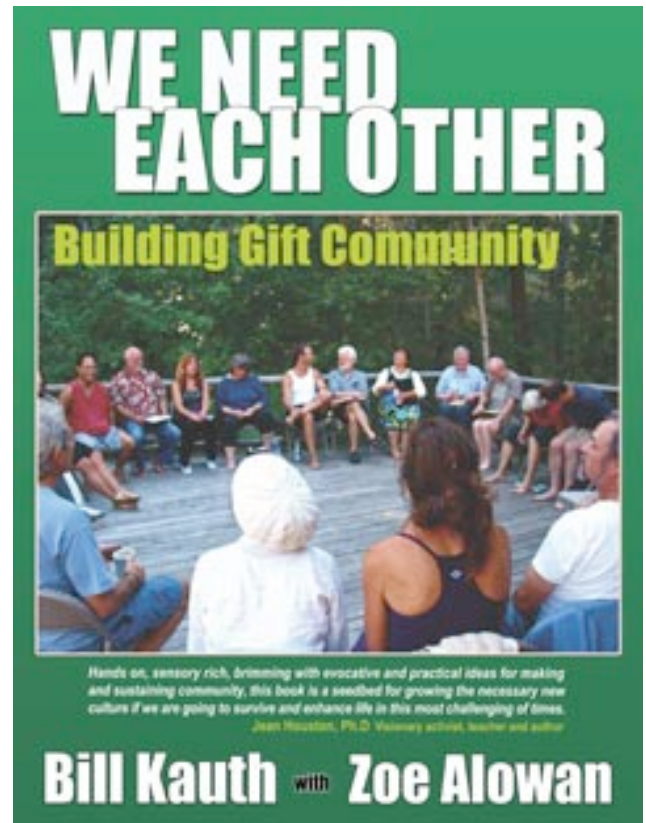


DO YOU YEARN FOR TRULY MEANINGFUL COMMUNITY?
